Garden regulations for the Großer Garten

The Großer Garten is a garden monument of European significance and a unique location for the appreciation of accomplished gardening art with all the senses. To ensure that all our guests are able to experience this garden free from disturbance, we request your compliance with the following regulations.

In the Großer Garten, the regulations pertaining to public safety and order in the federal capital Hanover are valid in the version dated 18.07.2007 and the regulations concerning the handling of dogs in the federal capital of Hanover in the version dated 01.08.2000.

The following regulations should be observed:

- An entrance fee is charged for access to the gardens. Persons without a valid entry ticket can be asked to leave the premises.
- Children under 14 are only permitted to enter the gardens if accompanied by an adult.
- Dogs are not permitted in the Großer Garten. This regulation does not apply to guide dogs with a dog harness accompanying blind persons.
- It is not permitted to ride or push bicycles through the gardens.
- Handcarts are only permitted for transporting small children through the garden.
- It is forbidden to remove, damage or destroy plants or any parts of plants and walk over flowerbeds, ornaments and borders.
- Please do not climb on statues, monuments and fountains or damage or soil these objects.
- For reason of safety, it is not allowed to clamber up barriers, fences and bars.
- Please do not feed pigeons, ducks or any other animals.
- Picnics and larger gatherings are only permitted within designated areas.
- Barbecues and open fires are prohibited.
- Ball games of all types are not permitted.
- Prams and pushchairs are prohibited in the grotto. It is also not permitted to ride E scooters in the grotto.
- Please do not touch the walls and installations in the grotto. Eating, drinking and smoking are prohibited in the grotto.
- Persons are not permitted to remain in the garden outside opening times.
- Filming and photography for private purposes is permitted from the paths. Permission for commercial filming and photography must be previously requested from the garden authority.
- For reasons of safety, the flying of unmanned aerospace systems such as drones or model helicopters over the garden is only permitted outside garden opening hours and with specific permission by the garden authority.
- Without specific prior permission, the parking or driving of motor vehicles is prohibited.
- Activities of all types which could lead to the inciting of public disturbance are forbidden.
- The instructions of garden, security and POS staff must be adhered to at all times.
- In the case of special events, separate regulations will apply.
